Hakone Barrier

The barrier and the shukuba (post station) of Hakone were established in 1619. Located at the highest place (725 meters) among the entire shukuba in the Old Tokaido, the Hakone barrier was called the "mountain barrier". It was abolished in 1869, but rebuilt in 1995.



Yamanaka Fort Ruins (Designated as historic site of Japan)

Hojo Ujiyasu was a samurai of the Warring States Period, ruled central and western Kanagawa Prefecture. Yamanaka Castle was built by him

in the 16th century and fell by Toyotomi Hideyoshi (a samurai came to power in 1590) in 1589.


